Akville enjoys her music therapy sessions run by Nordoff Robbins.

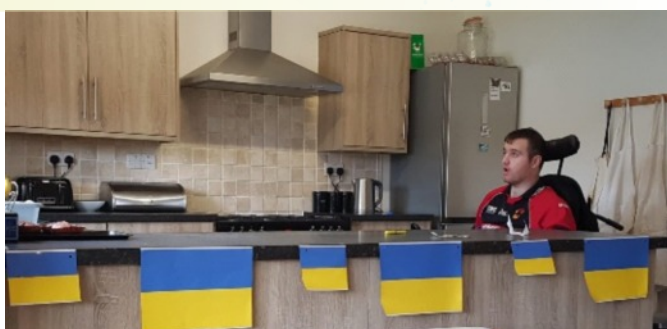
Chris and Jeanette went to the Reggae festival in Bradford - Jeanette was dancing on the stage!

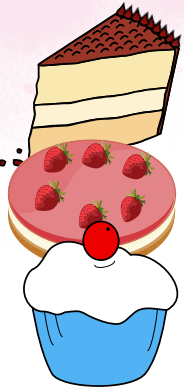

Our Values

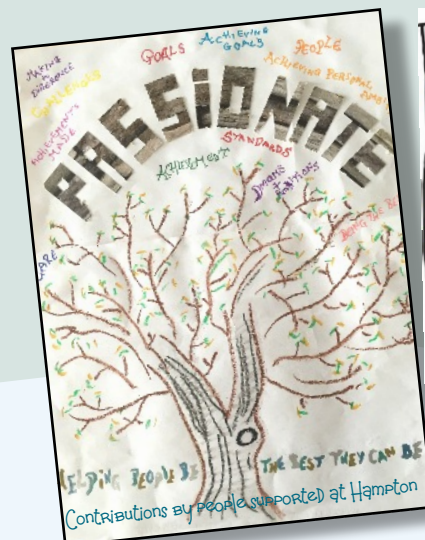
